
## **Cable Funding**

#### Declining Cable Revenue is Real.

We've been warning of the threats to PEG Funding for many years. Now we are seeing the decline from cutting cable services in favor of streaming.

Each Comcast Cable Subscriber in our area pays a 5.77% fee to satisfy Comcast's obligation to provide PEG Programming. 5% of that funding is goes towards Operating Expenses and .77% towards Capital Expenses. This year we are down by 8.69% from last year's funding.

Capital Funding is decreasing at a similar rate, down8.85% from the previous year.



### **Local Solutions**

In addition to the state and national advocacy work, CAT-TV is hard at work locally to supplement our funding decline by developing a paid membership structure and charging for production services. We are embarking on a new commercial underwriter program and launching fundraising incentives.


